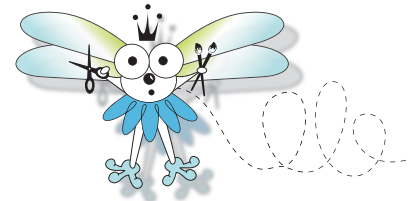


Oak Leaf

A template for hand carved stamps

1. Print out the above leaf template at 100% Scale. Cut with scissors along the outer rectangle edge.
2. With a #2 pencil, trace along all the black edges of the rectangle and the leaf design. Be sure to include all the details in the center of the leaf too.
3. Now flip the leaf design over, image side down, onto a white hi-polymer eraser such as Pentel brand or a Speedball carving block.
4. Tape the design in place and using medium pressure, color the back side with pencil - covering the entire
5. Gently lift one corner of the paper to be sure the image has transferred successfully. If the image is too light, go back over the back side again with the pencil. Medium pressure will help transfer the design.
6. Once the image is successfully transferred, carve out the design using a #1 Speedball carving tool.
7. Ink your stamp with an ink of your choice and begin stamping!
